

Thank you for scheduling your ophthalmic consultation with us. We are pleased to have you as our patient.

Please complete the enclosed paperwork and bring it, your insurance card(s), and a list of your current medication(s) to your appointment. We ask that you arrive 15 minutes early. New patient evaluations can expect to be at our office for approximately two hours. Patients are taken in order of scheduled appointment time, therefore, you may be asked to reschedule if you arrive more than 15 minutes after your time.

It is policy to collect all co-pays and known non-covered services at the appointment. The most common service not covered by insurance is refraction. If you are given a new prescription for glasses, there is a \$25.00 out-of-pocket charge due at the time of service.

For cataract evaluations, we perform measurements on the day of your exam; therefore it is necessary that you discontinue wearing your contacts prior to your examination. Please discontinue soft lenses for 1 week prior to measurements and RGP or hard lenses for one (1) month plus one additional week for every decade of wear.
